- THE CONSULATE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CALL FOR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS, AS CONSIDERED NECESSARY.
- An OCI Card may be approved and is valid for a life time. It must however be replaced each time a new passport is issued up to completion of 20 years of age, and once after completing 50 years.
- You may visit any of our BLS Centers to have your documentation verified and cross checked before you apply for your OCI.

Entry to BLS International Services Canada Inc., Indian Visa Application Centers (VAC):

- Due to the limited size of VACs, attorneys (those accompanying applicants), relatives, drivers, or friends are not allowed in the VAC. An applicant may however, bring one person to assist him/her if he or she is elderly, disabled, or a minor child.
