Entry to BLS International Services Canada Inc., Indian Visa Application Centers (VAC):

1. Due to the limited size of VACs, attorneys (those accompanying applicants), relatives, drivers, or friends are not allowed in the VAC.
2. An applicant may bring one person to assist him/her if he or she is elderly, disabled, or a minor child.
3. Applicants may have to wait outside the facility, so please dress according to weather conditions on the day of your visit.

Important:

1. Applicant must visit BLS center in person as Biometrics is mandatory for over 1 year duration Visas (this applies to applicants from 12 years to 70 years of age)
2. 5-10-year visa applications will not be accepted by post/mail.
3. Foreign visitors to Canada cannot apply for Indian visa services in Canada.
4. **The duration of the visa is subject to approval by the Consulate General of India, Toronto.**

In case of any errors, please fill a new online application form. Please note: BLS International employees cannot edit or make any changes to your online application form.
