 PLEASE NOTE: THE CONSULATE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO CALL FOR ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS, AS CONSIDERED NECESSARY. Entry to BLS International Services Canada Inc., Indian Visa Application Centers (VAC): Due to the limited size of VACs, attorneys (those accompanying applicants), relatives, drivers, or friends are not allowed in the VAC. Applicants should bear in mind that they may stand outside the facilities for their turn, please dress according to the weather conditions on the day of your visit. No passport or consular services are available to claimants of refugee status in BLS Centers. If you cannot visit the VAC, it is recommended that you use the postal service to submit your application. 	DOCUMENTS: Provide the documents below, in original and photocopies on letter size paper. Please note: Both your original Indian passport and status in Canada are to be submitted along with the photocopies of the same.
	Valid Indian Passport / Canadian / Foreign Passport: For Indian Passport holders, please bring copies of first and last page, copies of all immigration stamp pages to India, observations (if any) and endorsements. For Canadian / Foreign Passport holders – copy of photo ID page, copies of all immigration stamp pages to India, observations and endorsements, if any. If your present passport does not have any stamps, kindly provide the photocopies of the passport photo ID page and stamps in the passport you have travelled to India.
	 For former Indians that have acquired foreign citizenship, Surrender Certificate (if applicable) Surrendered Indian passport (first and last and observation page copy)
	 Status in Canada; Valid PR Card – front and back Landing paper - For PR cards issued, without the category on the back, please provide the photocopy of the PR card and landing paper If PR Card has expired: Expired PR Card, Landing Paper and PR Card renewal receipt Valid Work Permit or Student Permit Valid Visitor Visa
	Proof of address in Canada: Driver's License, Bank Statement or Utility Bill (The latter two must be less than 6 months old).
	Fees: Refer to fee schedule at: http://blsindia-canada.com/pol_clr_cert.php Mail In Applications: - - Enclose a certified cheque, in favor of 'BLS International Service Canada Inc.' to include: - O HCI/CGI Passport Fee. O ICWF Consular Surcharge Fee. - Enclose a separate certified cheque, in favor of 'BLS International Service Canada Inc.' to include: O BLS Processing Fee. O Add: Return Courier charges.
	Walk In Applications: In cash or by debit card only

The above guidelines are defined by the High Commission of India, Canada, for consular services for India, and must be strictly followed. The High Commission of India, Canada Information and Application Centre will not accept applications which do not meet above guidelines. They also reserve the right to ask for a personal interview. BLS International Services Canada Inc. have no say on whether you will be granted a visa/passport/PIO card/OCI card for India, as this is entirely the

prerogative of the High Commission of India, Canada. The Mission may also request for additional documentation at any time during or after the submission of the application.
